GOOD HAND WRITING

EASY TO READ AND GOOD TO LOOK

- Write slowly. when you write fast you lose out on clarity. Make sure that each letter is easy to recognize.
- Write without stressing yourself out. Writing should relax you.
- Keep your handwriting simple and graceful .Ornamental writing isn't always easy to read .
- Make sure the letters are formed right where they start, how they move and where they finish. Let them mark boldly across page.
- Space your letters out. If the spacing is inadequate, the sentence becomes difficult to read .
- Make sure the letters are neither too big nor too small. Letters with a body height of 3mm are ideal.
- You could develop a different style for a different occasion. For instance, try a slow elegant style for special occasions.
- Give your page proper margins - on the top as well as on the right and the left. A wider margin at the bottom also helps in framing the text.
